A Note about Simply Giving

You'll notice that the Offering Baskets are "pre-loaded" with cards which say, "I give electronically through Simply Giving." This is done so that others know people are not just passing up the chance to give when they put nothing in the basket. Those people are probably on Simply Giving.

Recently, some of those on Simply Giving have waved their hand to the usher rather than passing the Offering Basket down the row. We can assume they're signaling that they're on Simply Giving. But, there may be other people in the same row who are ready to make an offering.

If this happens when you're ushering, just ask the people to please pass the Offering Baskets down the row as a way of helping you collect the offering.

We will be making several announcements about this in order to help all the ushers do their job. Thanks.

BEFORE THE SERVICE:

- Arrive at church 15 minutes before service begins.
- Welcome people warmly and hand them a bulletin.
- Close doors just as service begins.
- Light candles a couple minutes before the service should begin, if acolyte fails to do so. You will need to bring up two fresh tealights and the candle lighter from the communion room.

DURING THE SERVICE:

- Pick up Prayer Requests during the song before the sermon. Take them to the Worship Leader during the song.
- Collect offering, and take it to the front toward the end of the offertory song when Kent or Kristi gets up to receive it.
- Record Attendance . Please wait until second song or first reading to get an accurate count . don't forget the nursery and musicians.
- Please note: When the choir or motion choir is up front, please collect the offering from the outside aisles and **NOT** down the center aisle.

AFTER THE SERVICE:

- Extinguish candles if Acolyte fails to do so.
- Tidy up after each service: Collect books, bulletins, etc. left behind on chairs after service.
- After the 8:00 service, please make sure the Welcome Books are at the end of each aisle.
- After 10:30 service, turn off lights, check baptismal font to be sure it has been emptied.
